First Reading: Isaiah 43: 16 - 21

God says not to remember the events from long ago, but to focus on the things he plans to do next. He also claims he will again help his chosen people when they need him.

Second Reading: Philippians 3: 8 - 14

Paul describes knowledge of Jesus as more important than knowledge of the Old Law. He wishes to share in the power of Jesus' resurrection, and speaks of concentrating on the finish line of the race with salvation as the prize to be won.

Gospel: John 8: 1 - 11

Jesus preached forgiveness of sin, but in the old law those accused of adultery were to be stoned. So the Pharisees tried to trap Jesus and brought to him a woman accused of adultery and asked him what he would do to her. Jesus said let the one who is without sin cast the first stone, and all of the elders then left. Jesus told the woman that he did not condemn her but told her to avoid such sin in the future.
